## Changes to Motor Vehicle Policy for New South Wales Government Motor Vehicles

The Expenditure Review Committee has directed that StateFleet implement a new Policy requiring all Government motor vehicles be retained for a minimum period of **36 months or 60,000 kilometres whichever occurs first, applicable to both passenger vehicles and light commercial vehicles.**

The new policy applies to all leased vehicles ordered through StateFleet from 1 July 2011. For Owned vehicles (i.e. not Leased) by a Department or Agency this policy applies immediately and Owned vehicles must be retained for a minimum of 36 months or 60,000 kms before being returned for sale.

### Examples

Term	Kilometres	
36 months	45,000kms	✓
24 months	60,000kms	✓
30 months	45,000kms	✗

In addition, the list of Allowable Accessories and Options for New South Wales Government Motor Vehicles has been amended to include Satellite Navigation Systems (factory fit) for country and city use. This change precludes post manufacturer accessory options.

Both these changes will be reflected in the Motor Vehicle Policy for New South Wales Government Vehicles and the terms and conditions of the StateFleet Leasing Arrangement.

It is imperative that all Departments and Agencies implement new motor vehicle procedures to ensure this Policy is observed by all staff.
